## **SHARON HARRIS**

## Designer, Painter, Play Director

A Texas native, Sharon was born in Ft. Worth and grew up in Grapevine, Texas. She moved to North Carolina in 1970 where she and her husband of 57 years, Mac Harris, lived before moving in 1998 to Citrus County, Fl.

A 1973 graduate of Appalachian State University, she graduated Summa Cum Laude with a Bachelor's degree in Industrial and Fine Arts. Sharon is a mother, grandmother and great-grandmother who pursued a career in Architecture as a business

owner and general contractor, then in 1993 retired to concentrate on her art.

Art was a childhood interest for Sharon that continued throughout her adult life, where she




achieved recognition and numerous awards as a clay sculptor and painter who exhibited from the North Carolina Museum of Art to regional art exhibitions across North Carolina and Florida. Her paintings and clay works are held in private collections in North and South Carolina, Texas, Oklahoma, New Hampshire and Florida. After moving to Citrus County, she served as Vice President and then for six terms as President of the Art Center of Citrus County. During her presidency she dedicated her business skills toward building a state-of-the-art community theatre and renovate the existing, 1984 visual arts building located on the four-acre campus. The theatre was completed in 2003 and the visual arts building was renovated in 2007.

AWARD OF MERIT WEBER GALLERY

Since then she has served as a director of plays and musicals and performed as an actress in numerous plays. She created the Art Center's youth education program, is the former President of the Ocala Art Group and a member of the board for Acrylic Painters USA.

She has judged exhibitions for the Visual Arts Association, Villages Art Association, National Congressional Competition, District 11, and multiple competitions for Citrus County organizations. She works in a studio at her home and instructs others in drawing and painting in acrylics at the Art Center of Citrus County.

#### **ENTRY DEADLINE: September 17, 2021**

To enter show or visit our website, <a href="http://www.acrylicpaintersusa.com">http://www.acrylicpaintersusa.com</a>, and click "Enter Shows – EntryThingy".

**ELIGIBILITY:** Any member or student member using acrylic medium. Accepted artwork must be original, at least 80% acrylic, and less than 3 years old.

**DISPLAY RULES:** Accepted works must be wired and ready to hang. Taped wire ends. Accepted art must be made available for the entire exhibit. Failure to exhibit work will result in the artist's ineligibility to enter APUSA shows for the next two years.

**SIZE RESTRICTIONS:** Maximum 1,600 square inches with an additional and optional 2" frame. Minimum size is 80 square inches.

**FRAMED WORK:** Frames must be PLAIN wood or metal, not to exceed 2" in width. For framed paper, use plexiglass - NO GLASS. Matting is optional. Any mat or liner must be White.

**UNFRAMED CANVAS**: Unframed canvas must be gallery wrapped with painted sides.

**ENTRY FEES:** \$45 for one or two images. APUSA 2021 Membership dues (\$35) must be current to enter. This year we are using EntryThingy for our entries. To submit work, visit our website, www.acrylicpaintersusa.com, and click Enter Shows-EntryThingy. Fees and dues may be included in one payment online via PayPal ( PayPal also allows payment with a credit card) located at EntryThingy.

**DELIVERY:** Accepted painting may be hand delivered to ArtCenter Manatee, 209 9th St.West, Bradenton. FL 34205 on October 23, 2021 from 9am to noon.

**SHIPPED PAINTINGS** must arrive between October 19 and 22, 2021, at ArtCenterManatee 209 9th St. west, Bradenton, FL 34205. Include a \$20 check paid to ArtCenterManatee for handling and repacking. and include a prepaid return shipping label.ArtCenter Manatee agrees to encourage sales and receives a 35% commission on sold paintings.


## **Upcoming in August**
