

# 2021-2022 SURVEY

Summary of 41 Responses to a 12 Question Online Survey

Submitted to the OAG Board by Barbara Fife August 12, 2021

#### **BACKGROUND**

The Board decided at the June 2021 meeting to survey the membership for their input to help plan meetings, programs, exhibits and other activities for the 2021-2022 season. The survey was to be conducted online using the service SurveyMonkey.com.

Questions for the survey were submitted by Board Members. President Lee Asta proposed guidelines for the direction and content of the survey.

Barbara Fife organized the input into 12 questions on SurveyMonkey. Sixty-five email addresses from a Membership Roster provided by Membership Chairperson Heather Doherty comprised the mailing list. Email invitations from SurveyMonkey were sent, and reminder notices were sent at weekly intervals to those who had not completed the Survey.


Of the 65 persons who received Survey invitations, 41 completed the survey, a 63% return.

# Q1 How would you describe yourself as an artist?



## Q2 How do you prefer the Ocala Art Group be perceived?




















